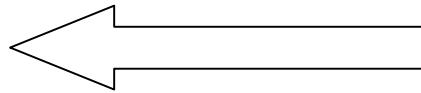

Club member Bob Mehler, UCF '96, is the newly appointed Province President covering chapters in part of Florida. Bob has been a member of our club for years, and has served as the chapter advisor at UCF for many years. He has also been a voting representative for our club at more than one bi-annual convention.

So what does a Province President do? For administrative purposes, the chapters of the Fraternity are divided into geographical subdivisions called provinces. Each province is assigned a president who is a Phi Delta Theta alumnus volunteering his service to the Fraternity. The Province President is appointed to a two-year term of office by the General Council subject to the approval of the chapters in the respective area. The role of the Province President is to serve as deputy of the General Council in safeguarding the welfare of the Fraternity in the section committed to his care. The Province President appoints and educates chapter advisory board chairmen, assists in the expansion of the Fraternity in his area, and makes visits to chapters to work with chapter officers, encouraging and assisting in the success of individual chapters.

Bob has truly embraced his pledge to "strive in all ways to transmit the Fraternity to those who may follow after, not only not less, but greater than it was transmitted to me."
